How the Route 66 Passport Works

To participate in the Oklahoma Route 66 Passport program, travelers can download the official TravelOK Trip Planner app, available on the Apple App Store and Google Play Store. At each participating stop, a code is displayed that travelers can enter to digitally check in. The passport is divided into Eastern, Central (milo is here), and Western sections. Upon completing all stops in a section, participants can visit one of the nine Oklahoma Tourism Information Centers to receive a piece of a Route 66 magnet. Completing all three sections earns a collectible Route 66 coin.
